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Neural Therapy

The Gentle Healing Technology from Germany



Neural therapy is a treatment system for chronic pain and illness. It involves the injection of local anesthetics (also, other non-invasive modalities) into structures that are primarily innervated by the autonomic nervous system: the sympathetic and parasympathetic ganglia, perineural tissues of the somatosensory nerves, perivascular autonomic nerves, scars, glands, fascia and periosteum, ligaments and joint capsules, trigger points, and others. It has been shown that tissues which have been traumatized through surgery, accidents, illness, or exposure to toxins can exhibit long-standing electrochemical changes, which in turn may lead to the ongoing generation of abnormal signals. These signals travel in the form of action potentials in the unmyelinated nerves—the C-fibers of the nociceptive system—and both afferent and efferent sympathetic axons. This constant arousal of the nociceptive and sympathetic system may lead to 1) Profound general neurochemical changes with lasting up-regulation of the sympathetic and nociceptive system; 2) Vasoconstriction (norepinephrine or endothelin mediated) and sensitization of specific tissues; and 3) Changes of ion and substrate transport across cell membranes. The symptom(s) caused by these injured tissues may be located far away from the site of the original dysfunction

in a non-dermatomal distribution. A scar from a gallbladder surgery may cause migraine headaches, a tonsillectomy scar—low back pain. Any injured group of cells may cause dysfunction anywhere else in the body. By finding the original site of the injury and treating this area with a single injection of local anesthetic, the abnormal signal generation is often permanently terminated, restoring again normal function to the organism.

Neural Therapy is a comprehensive treatment system that has evolved in Germany over the last 70 years and is one of the most widely used modalities in the treatment of chronic pain in Central Europe and South America today. The injection techniques are simple, safe, and easy to learn. Since most papers published on the subject are in German (and some in Spanish), this very effective treatment is largely unknown in the non-German speaking countries. Neural Therapy is an empirical method which was developed initially through observation and experimentation—very much like acupuncture or osteopathic manipulative therapy. The physician who is credited with the greatest contributions in this area is Ferdinand Huneke, M.D., D.D.S. Dietrich Klinghardt, M.D., Ph.D., is considered one of the foremost Neural Therapy practitioners and teachers, both in Europe as well as in North America.

Dietrich Klinghardt, M.D., Ph.D. is known for his successful treatment of chronic pain and illness, which combines Neural Therapy with the principles of Orthopedic Medicine. He studied medicine and psychology in Freiburg, West Germany. After graduating, he conducted three years of research on the dysfunction of the autonomic nervous system in the upper

extremity at the Albert-Ludwig University in Freiburg. He currently resides in Seattle, Washington, from where he is lecturing internationally on the treatment of chronic pain. He has been teaching Neural Therapy since 1979. Due to his innovative contributions to Neural Therapy, he has been invited regularly in recent years to teach workshops at the prestigious "Medicine Week" in Baden-Baden, Germany. He is also known in Europe for his teaching in psychosomatic medicine. His German textbook on applied psycho-neuro biology has become a best-seller in the holistic medical field and community, and his teaching institute in Stuttgart has touched the lives of thousands.

“Healing Anesthesia”: Treating Chronic Pain and Illness with Injections for Physicians, Dentists, and other Health Care Practitioners

Instructor: Dietrich Klinghardt, M.D., Ph.D.

In this three-day intensive, the practitioner will be introduced to the history and theory of Neural Therapy. The appropriate use of different local anesthetics and prevention and treatment of drug reactions will be discussed. All important injection techniques will be introduced and demonstrated: injection of autonomic ganglia and peripheral nerves, scars, glands, acupuncture and trigger points, and segmental therapy points. The course participants are encouraged to volunteer for treatment of their own health problems.

Protocols for heavy metal detoxification using DMSA, D-Penicillamine, DMPS, and other agents will be given. Clinical Nutritionist Gray Graham will give a brief introduction to the intelligent use of nutritional supplements and his unique way of establishing the respective need of each product using hands-on functional tests.

For each injection procedure, we will demonstrate non-invasive alternatives (**Neural Therapy without needles**): Low Level Laser Therapy, the Electro-Bloc™, hands-on techniques, and more. This makes the technique suitable for safe use in most chiropractic and naturopathic offices. In addition to delivering simple, safe, effective, and practical tools for your practice, this workshop is designed to give you a broad basis for the understanding of true “Holistic Medicine.” Dr. Klinghardt passes on the secrets and information gathered by his mentors in Europe over many generations.

“Healing Anesthesia”: Treating Chronic Pain and Illness with Injections for Physicians, Dentists, and other Health Care Practitioners

This course focuses on the contemporary understanding of the anatomy and physiology of the autonomic nervous system. It will deepen the understanding of electrophysiological events (that form the rationale for the injection of local anesthetics) and the understanding of how the autonomic nervous system affects and directs our health.

On Day 1 you will learn the unique Neural Therapy approach to the diagnosis of autonomic dysfunction using conventional neurological tests, abnormal reflexes, skin temperature changes, X-rays, lab tests, autonomic response testing, and characteristic findings in the patient history and symptomatology. All advanced Neural Therapy techniques will be demonstrated: caudal epidural injections, the autonomic ganglion blocks (ciliary, sphenopalatine, gasserian, submandibular, upper cervical, stellate, lumbar sympathetic, Frankenhauser ganglion), and the injection of the autonomic plexi (thyroid, celiac, and others).

On Day 2 you will learn the diagnosis and treatment of the dental interference field (jaw bone abnormalities such as sclerotic and necrotic areas, cysts, NICO lesions, dental galvanism, trigger points, TMJ related problems) and the diagnosis and treatment of systemic toxicity and

allergies caused by dental materials and exposure to toxic metals. Neural therapy protocols for chronic pain and most chronic illnesses will be shared during the demonstrations. Russ Borneman DDS, one of the leading biological dentists in the US, will present the latest on compatible dental materials, proper amalgam-filling removal and composite-placement techniques and other practical tips and insights.

All injection techniques and their indications will be carefully explained in detail and also the diagnostic test for each ganglion. Alternative approaches without the use of needles, using Low Level Laser Therapy (LLLT), the Electro-Bloc™, and other modalities will be demonstrated.

In this workshop Dr. Klinghardt will introduce the latest research on the anatomy and physiology of the autonomic nervous system. He will also discuss his rational and simplified approach of how to diagnose and correct hormonal deficiencies and other problems in the biochemistry of a patient.

Autonomic Response Testing (A.R.T. I)

Instructors: Dietrich Klinghardt, M.D., Ph.D. and Gray Graham, Nutritionist

In this three-day intensive, Dr. Klinghardt will teach how to use muscle testing, the arm-length reflex, and manual palpation as the most natural and accurate biofeedback instruments which enable the practitioner to “listen” for stress signals from the patient’s autonomic nervous system while performing a thorough physical exam, or while performing any type of intervention. This hands-on course is equally important for medical doctors, osteopaths, dentists, and all other health practitioners. A.R.T. incorporates elements from “Neuralkinesiology,” a sophisticated examination technique that was co-created by both Dr. Klinghardt, M.D., and L. Williams, D.C., N.D., and also applies new findings from neurobiology, resonance physics, and Dr. Klinghardt’s own research. The participants will be briefly introduced to the practice and science of the Bi-Digital O-Ring Test, in a way that honors and respects its discoverer, Yoshiaki Omura, M.D., of New York.

Day 1: Review of the anatomy and neurobiology of the autonomic nervous system (ANS). Neurotoxicity and the connection to the limbic system. Current concepts of the innervation of the muscle spindle and the different phenomena observed in muscle testing/arm length testing. Muscle testing as the most reliable indicator of the state of the ANS. Recent research on resonance phenomena, neuropeptides, and axonal transport. Review of the standard neurological exam: the cranial nerves; upper and lower motor neuron signs; exam of the motor and sensory system; orthopedic exam of the spine, shoulder, knee, and hip; the use of the inclinometer for the documentation of joint motion before and after treatment. Internal Medicine exam: palpation of organs and skin.

Day 2: Practical introduction to muscle testing. Getting familiar with the standard tests: “Straight Arm Test,” the “Thumb Opposition Test” (“O-ring test”), and the “Arm-Length Reflex.” Checking our biofeedback instrument for reliability and sensitivity: the seven factors of “blocked regulation.” Unblocking the ANS—the great discovery of “Neural kinesiology.” Autonomic Response Testing (A.R.T.): diagnosing disturbance of the corpus callosum and the neocortex. Autoimmune states: diagnosis and treatment. Finding and treating the primary interference field or focus. Subclinical illness of organ systems and the blood. Psychosomatic illness.

Learn to diagnose food allergies, geopathic stress, interference fields, subclinically ill organs and structures, emotional blocks, heavy metal toxicity—non-invasively and without having to buy another “machine” – with an easy-to-learn hands-on approach!

Day 3: Applied A.R.T.: Finding the most effective and least toxic/least invasive treatment; “2-pointing” and the practical use of resonance phenomena. Biocompatibility of dental materials. Prioritizing. Diagnosis of dental problems: infections, cavitations, electro galvanism, toxicity of cervico-cranial ganglia. Facial pain syndromes. The latest on mercury detox and the treatment of NICO lesions. Using A.R.T. to guide surgery, dental interventions, medical therapy (antibiotics, chemotherapy), Neural Therapy, acupuncture, herbal therapy and homeopathy with supplements and psychotherapy. Practical tips and tricks for the dentist and the busy practitioner. Inverted organ frequencies and scanning of X-rays/MRIs.

A.R.T. is a must for the advanced Neural Therapy practitioner and the physician who desires to improve their diagnostic skills. It also opens the door for the higher levels of workshops offered by AANT.

Clinical Nutritionist, Gray Graham will teach his unique approach (“functional testing”) to determine the need for nutritional supplements. The Coca Pulse Test (for quick and reliable food allergy testing) and the intelligent use of the Chapman reflexes will be demonstrated and practiced.

The attending practitioners will be introduced to Heart Rate Variability testing as an objective way to verify the A.R.T. findings. Demonstrations and testing on the course participants throughout the weekend are part of the course.

Advanced A.R.T. (ART II)

A Hands-On Course

Instructors: Dietrich Klinghardt, M.D., Ph.D.

Gray Graham, Clinical Nutritionist

ART-I has introduced the 3 basics of this method, which are all aimed at treating the ground system (**extracellular** space): 1. Unblocking and optimizing regulation of the ANS; 2. Correcting switching (= treating minimal brain dysfunction) 3. Finding and treating interference fields

In ART-II we will introduce sound methods to diagnose **intracellular** dysfunction. To access intracellular information the "direct resonance test" allows us to diagnose and treat such diverse disorders as cancer, chlamydia and viral infections. Other medical researchers, such as Yoshiaki Omura MD of New York, have applied the same phenomenon which was originally discovered in the Physics-Department at New York's Columbia University in the 1940s (as a byproduct of the Manhattan Project). In his teaching of the Bi-Digital O-Ring Test (BDORT) he named this observation from applied physics the "resonance phenomenon between

identical substances." The underlying laws of physics will be discussed in detail. Practical applications will be demonstrated: treatment of chronic pain, various forms of cancer, chronic fatigue, neurological illnesses (Bell's palsy, Parkinson's, Alzheimer's, Multiple Sclerosis).

A valuable use of ART is the retrieval of hidden information from X-rays, mammograms, CAT-scans, MRIs and ultrasound images. Using the resonance test we can determine with high accuracy if the changes seen on a mammogram are malignant or not, whether the "discogenic" back pain is really caused by viral infection, if migrated intraoral bacteria are causing the episodes of angina and so on ... Even though we have used this test for many years it was again the research by Y. Omura who recently provided the scientific rationale which will also be discussed at this course.

Other topics:

- How to open regulation and treat switching with the use of the eye-movement technique and colored glasses.
- Practice of the arm-length reflex and other forms of autonomic reflex testing as an alternative for practitioners that have trouble with muscle testing.
- What to do when unblocking a patient is impossible or too difficult.
- ART in dentistry: careful evaluation of the teeth, gums and jawbone for various types of pathology; resonance testing of X-rays; ART-monitoring of a patient during a dental intervention; testing of dental materials.
- A section of the course will be dedicated to Nutritional/biochemical assessment.
- D. Klinghardt will discuss the prudent use of lab tests (Body-Bio blood and fatty acid test), hormone testing and cancer screening.
- Gray Graham will teach selected elements of his method of using autonomic mediated reflexes (such as vascular tenderness in the calf to assess the tissue calcium status) to determine the need for targeted nutrient supplementation.

Applied Psycho-Neurobiology (APN I)

Psycho-Kinesiology: A Hands-On Course

Biofeed

Instructor: Dietrich Klinghardt, M.D., Ph.D.

Chronic pain and illness have four components which can be identified in virtually every patient:

1. **Structural Component:** Physical therapy, manipulation, craniosacral therapy, and structural dental work (orthodontics) are the most effective treatment modalities in this category.

2. **Biochemical Component:** Everything in the PDR, botanicals, homeopathy, orthomolecular medicine, and detoxifying procedures address this category.

3. **Electromagnetic Component:** Acupuncture, body work, and Neural Therapy are the most effective interventions in this component.

4. **Psycho-emotional Component:** Every human interaction works on this level, but all of the psychotropic medications and psychotherapeutic interventions are aimed at this component.

The American Academy of Neural Therapy has shown that every chronic illness has each of these four components, which should be appropriately diagnosed and treated. One treatment for each category should be given simultaneously — not one after the other. For many years, the Academy

focused on teaching the most effective interventions on the first three of these four components.

We encouraged cooperation between medical and osteopathic physicians, dentists, and chiropractors. It is time now to focus on the treatment of the often most neglected and at the same time most important problem, the psycho-emotional component.

Unresolved emotional conflicts (UEC) and unresolved emotional trauma (UET) from early childhood are constantly active in the limbic system (which is part of our unconscious mind) and communicate via the limbic-hypothalamic axis with the autonomic nervous system (ANS). The UEC/UET leads to a constant conflict specific arousal of portions of the ANS, leading to vasoconstriction and cell membrane changes in the target organs and areas, causing chronic pain and illness.

We could show that the changes made in muscle strength—observed in various kinesiological testing procedures—are mediated by the ANS. Therefore, muscle testing can be used as the ideal tool to obtain feedback about the state of

arousal of the ANS. When the therapist asks the patient a question, which approaches a UEC, the subconscious sends a stress signal via the ANS to the body, which can be detected with a simple muscle test. Through a series of appropriate questions and "autonomic response biofeedback" from the ANS, the UEC can be rapidly uncovered. Applied Psycho Neurobiology allows an intimate dialogue with the subconscious. We are utilizing a number of techniques that have been shown to allow faster and easier access to the UEC, such as conflict-specific color, sound, eye movements, and others. Once the conflict is uncovered, the healing can begin. We will introduce simple and effective ways to disengage the ANS from the UEC/UET and resolve restricting beliefs that were formed at the time of the original trauma.

APN is easy to learn and does not require prior training as a psychotherapist. Even though the results are often dramatic and lasting, the technique is very safe and gentle. Dr. Klinghardt published a bestselling medical textbook in Germany on the subject (which is currently being translated into English). On the first day of the seminar we will

learn how to recognize if a physical problem has a psycho-emotional component. Using a simple flowchart, we will learn how to "dialogue" with the subconscious and how to uncover the UEC.

On the second day three different methods to uncouple the ANS will be shown: 1) the tapping of ANS receptors in the cranial sutures; 2) eye movement uncoupling; and 3) uncoupling with colored glasses. 
